



Baltimore Festival Pie Baking Contest Contest Rules 2008

- ⊕ Anyone who resides in Fairfield County is eligible to enter the contest. The contest is open to amateur bakers only.
- ⊕ Pie crust and filling must be prepared and baked by the individual submitting the pie entry for judging.
- ⊕ All entries must include the recipe listing all the ingredients, and baked in a disposable aluminum pie tin.
- ⊕ Pies entered for judging may be made from fresh or frozen fillings; no store bought pie dough or canned fillings permitted.
- ⊕ Only pies that do not need refrigeration will be accepted; for example no custard or cream cheese type pies. They must also be at room temperature for judging.
- ⊕ All pies become the property of the Baltimore Festival and will not be returned to the contestant. The remainder of the pie will be sold by the slice following the judging and announcement of winners.
- ⊕ A \$1 entry fee is required with each completed entry form. A separate entry form must be completed for each pie entered. There is a limit of 3 different pies per person.
- ⊕ First Place in each division will receive \$75, second \$50 and third \$25. There will be two divisions: Adult (18 and up) and Juvenile (17 and under)
- ⊕ Entries will be taken from 12-1pm Saturday August 9th behind the Johnson Park shelter house off Summers Choice Dr. Judging will begin at 1pm, and winner will be announced at 2pm unless judging time is extended due to numerous entries.
- ⊕ Entry forms can be mailed any time prior to the event, or turned in with the pie the day of the contest. For further information please see contact information below.
